Check Pilot helpful Hints for a Form 91 Checkride

- ❑ Have a current CAPR 60-1 plus supplements in your possession
- ❑ Use attachment 8 of CAPR 60-1 as checklist
- ❑ Make sure applicant has completed the Form 91 pre-check package
- ❑ Review completed Mission Pilot Training record with applicant if this is initial check (attached), if renewal ask key questions about grid procedures (i.e. density altitude, track spacing, turbulence in mountains and desert. etc.)
- ❑ Have applicant show logbook for currency and type of missions flown in past two years.
- ❑ Have a copy of audio panel, GPS and CAP radio cheat sheets available on the CAWG website
- ❑ Have applicant demonstrate use of GPS (enter waypoint, show Lat/Long, scroll info)
- ❑ Have applicant demonstrate use of audio panel (ISO switch) and CAP radio
- ❑ Use Mountain Fury form 91 guide as basis for conducting your checkride which is available on the CAWG website
- ❑ They must be in proper uniform (with proper patches, etc), flight suit, and boots (leather no mesh, above the ankle).
